Required Documents

<input type="checkbox"/>	Proof of at least 60 days of the victim's income prior to the victimization. If the victim was employed less than 60 days prior to the victimization, please send proof of income since their hire date (For example, Pay Stubs, Payroll History, W-2 Form Federal Tax Return, 1099 Form, etc.)
<input type="checkbox"/>	Copy of Business License, if applicable (only if victim was self-employed)
<input type="checkbox"/>	Proof of employment. The victim's employer may submit A) the enclosed Employment Verification Form along with their business card or blank business letterhead <u>or</u> B) a Letter on business letterhead with their business contact information stating the following: <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. victim's dates of employment2. hourly wage3. number of hours worked per week.

<input type="checkbox"/>	Proof of child support, if applicable (For example, child support payment summary, cancelled checks, etc)
